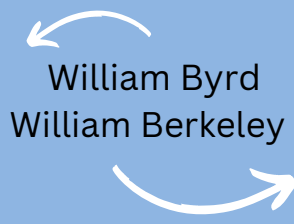

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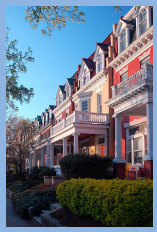
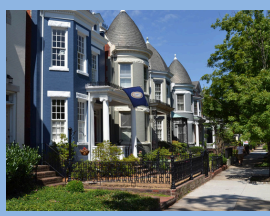
# The Fan District

# What types of architectural styles were used?



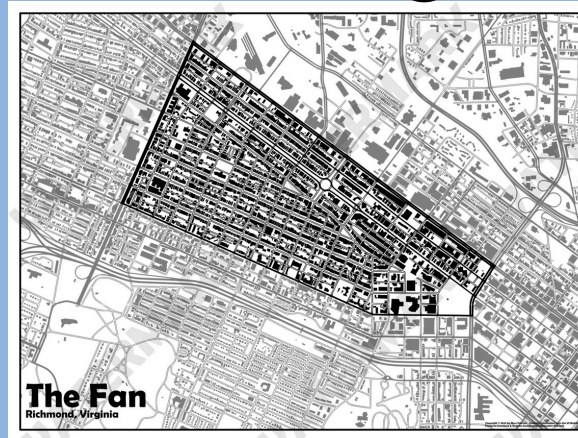
